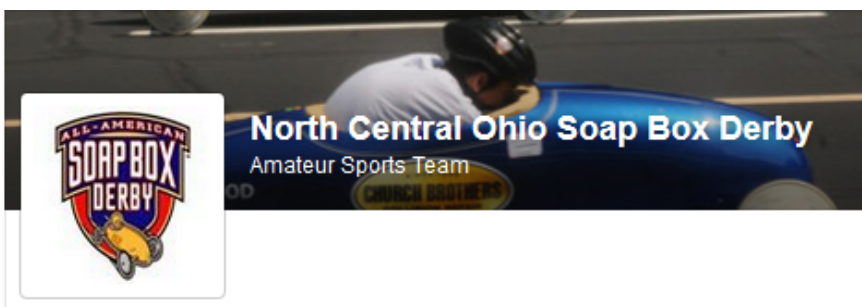


The Derby will be held June 18th on North Main Street in downtown Mansfield.
